Anchor Bay Schools is pleased to provide an opportunity for School Age Child Care (SACC) while Anchor Bay Schools remain closed for Face-to-Face learning. Our SACC program will utilize licensed cafeterias and gyms to provide care in a safe and healthy manner and to provide social distancing.

Registrations will be processed on a first come first served basis, availability is limited. A registration link will be provided if space is available. Absences will be charged at the regular rate for sessions children are scheduled to attend. Fees will NOT be charged for an extended illness beyond three (3) consecutive days provided the Early Childhood office is notified. To register you must have a zero balance. students are required to attend a minimum of 2 days a week, and weekly tuition is based on your weekly schedule.

State of Michigan Child Care Licensing COVID-19 Guidelines:

- Limit registration to promote social distancing
- Parents and students will be greeted at door for student check-in and check-out
- Only staff and registered students will be allowed to enter the building
- Staff will monitor children for signs of illness
 - Fever chills, cough, sore throat, fatigue, muscle or body aches, headache, new loss of taste or smell, shortness of breath or difficulty breathing, congestion runny nose, nausea or vomit, and diarrhea
 - If a temperature is 100.4 or above the student will be sent home and not permitted to return for 24 hours after fever is reduced without medication
 - Students exhibiting 2 or more signs of COVID 19 symptoms must remain home for a period of 10 days and will be permitted to return with a doctor's note
- Staff and students will be required to wear masks while indoors
- Weather permitting increased outdoor play
